Additionally, you can wander around the grounds to the Pagoda taking in the trees and up to the view of the River Thames and Ham House.

There is an Explorer Train which operates every day of the week on the hour from 11am. It departs from Victoria Gate and tickets need to be purchased on the day with the driver. The current price is £6.50 per adult. There is no concession rate, however essential carers go free. The train cannot be pre-booked, so it is on a first come first served basis.

The entry ticket also includes entry to Kew Palace, the Marianne North exhibition and the Shirley Sherwood Gallery.

Finally, there are numerous places to eat and drink and if it is a lovely day, then sitting on a bench having a picnic is a great idea.
